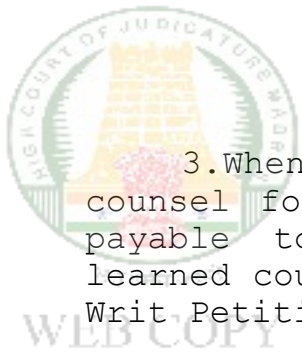
JUDGMENT

The Writ Petition was filed against the order of the first appellant, dated 4.11.2006, wherein, the award of punishment was imposed on the Writ Petitioner by lowering one stage from the basic pay.The said Writ Petition was allowed by this Court by order dated 26.6.2012. Aggrieved by the same, the Writ Appeal has been filed by the appellant/Bank.
