In the meanwhile the respondent police completed investigation and filed final report and the same has been taken cognizance in C.C.No.344 of 2021. The respondent have stated that the petitioners got anticipatory bail and they were on bail, this fact recorded by them is not correct.

4.At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners seek permission of this Court to withdraw the petition.

5.In view of the same, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
