PRAYER IN CRL A(MD) No.458 of 2019:

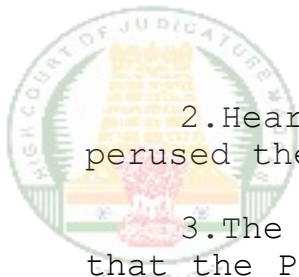

3.The learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner would state that the Petitioner has been arrayed as A6 in the criminal case and he has been complying with the conditions regularly from 02.12.2019. It is also stated that similar condition imposed on A5 was relaxed by this Court in Crl.M.P(MD)No.2209 of 2021, dated 16.3.2021.

4.Mr.S.Chandrasekar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent, on instructions, submitted that the Petitioner has been complying with the conditions since 02.12.2019.

5.In the light of the above submissions made on either side, we are inclined to relax the condition directing the Petitioner to appear before the Committal Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30a.m., until further orders.

6.This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is ordered accordingly.
