Prayer: This Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, forbearing the third respondent from interfering with the civil dispute with regard to the petitioner's Punja Land viz., Thenpothuvakudi Village, Paramakudi Sub Division, Ramanathapuram District, comprised in Survey No.187/2, Patta No.109, to an extend of 5 Acre 29 cents and not to demand the petitioner to hand over the property in favour of the Respondents 4 and 5.

4.Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances, there shall be a direction to the second respondent not to interfere with the civil dispute between the petitioner and the respondents 4 and 5 and it is left open to the parties to agitate their rights before the competent Civil Court.

5.This Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
