When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.601, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XV) Department, dated 04.02.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked by the Government.
