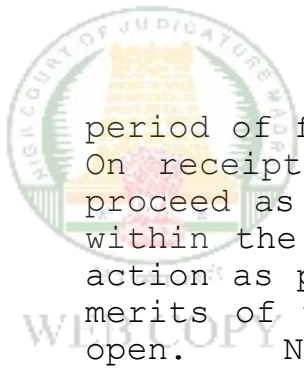

2. What is under challenge is only an order of provisional assessment. In the impugned communication dated 12.08.2011, it has been clearly stated that if the petitioner is desirous of filing objections, he can do so. Without doing so, the petitioner rushed to this Court. Therefore, the writ petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to lodge his objections within a



period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. On receipt of objections from the petitioner, the respondent can proceed as per law. If the petitioner fails to lodge any objection within the aforesaid period, it is open to the respondents to take action as per law. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter. The contentions of the petitioner are left open. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
