ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

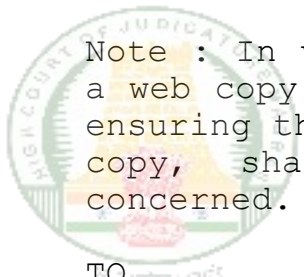
The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner circulated letter to the Registry dated 11.02.2021 seeking permission of this Court to withdraw the petition.
