3.Considering the said submissions made by the petitioner, the second respondent is directed to follow the guidelines issued in the decision in **D.K.Basu Vs. State of West Bengal reported in AIR (1997) SC 610.**

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4.With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
