5. In view of the aforesaid, where the order in entirety since has been complied with, this Contempt Petition is closed. No costs.

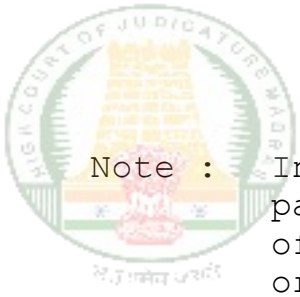
