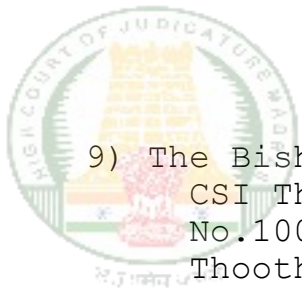

2. In view of the above, the Writ Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

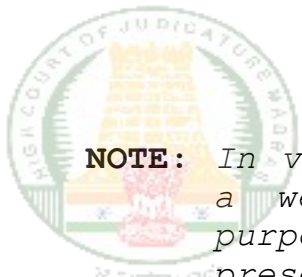
