2. Recording the same, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

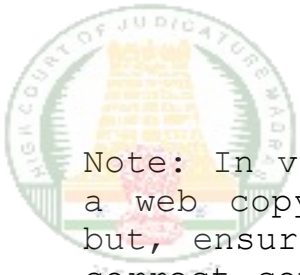
