For R1 to R3 : Mr.K.Dinesh Babu

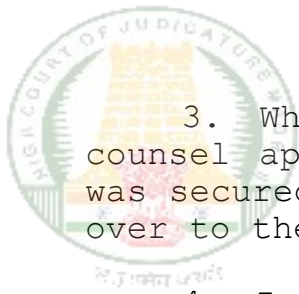
