3.Recording the said submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

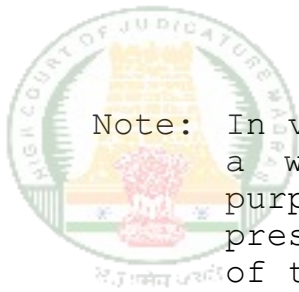
