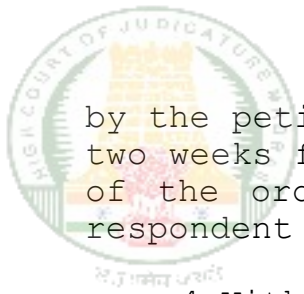

4. With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
