Prayer in WP(MD). 5658/ 2015 :

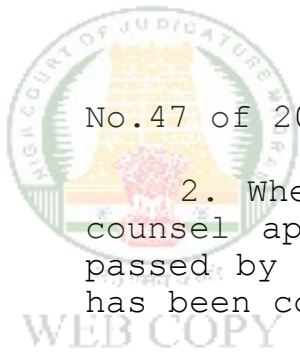
