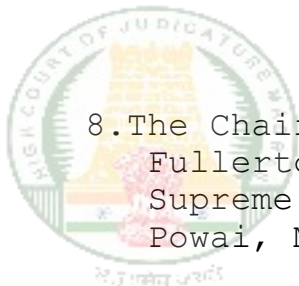

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2.The petitioner is said to have availed financial assistance from the sixth respondent. Due to pandemic situation, the petitioner was unable to repay the monthly dues.

3.The allegation of the petitioner is that the financier has been sending goondas and recovery agents and is harassing the petitioner. In this regard, the petitioner has given a representation to the second respondent. The petitioner wants this Court to direct the second respondent to take action on his complaint. In similar cases, I have taken the view that it is entirely for the second respondent to take such action as he deems fit and it is not for this Court to issue any particular direction.

4.With these observations, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

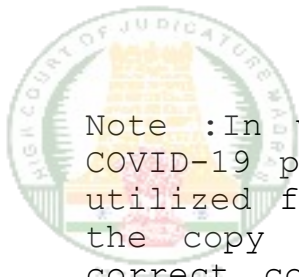
