3.With this liberty to the petitioner, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

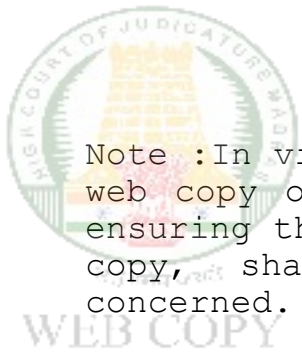
