2.In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

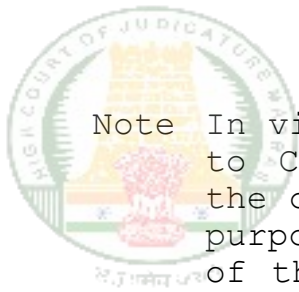
