3.Recording the aforesaid submissions, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

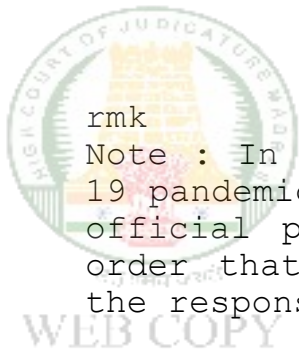
