Advocate (criminal side, this Petition is dismissed.

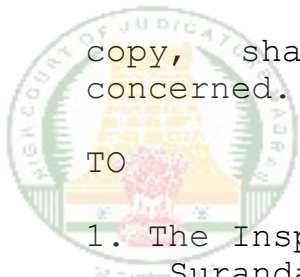
