Prayer IN CRL MP(MD). No.894 of 2021 :-

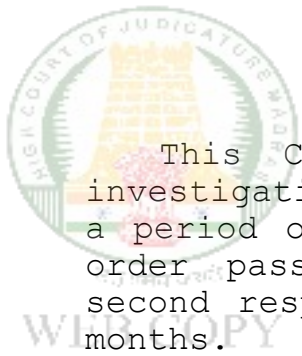
