3.With the above observations, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

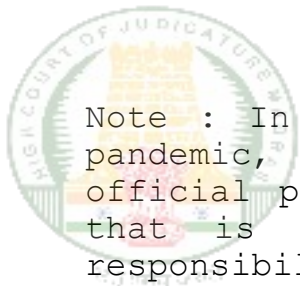
