Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the I Additional District Judge (Special Court for PCR Act Cases), Trichy District, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender in Crime No.1126 of 2020 on the file of the second respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioners are accused in Crime No.1126 of 2020 of Jeeyapuram Police Station, Trichy and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324, 427, 379 and 506(1) of the India Penal Code and Sections 3(1) (r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.



2.The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the I Additional District Judge, (Special Court for PCR Act Cases), Trichy District, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.R.Erottuchamy, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application on the same day of surrender, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1) The petitioners should appear before the I Additional District Judge, (PCR Act Cases), Trichy District, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2) On such surrender, the I Additional District Judge, (PCR Act Cases), Trichy District, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
