ORDER

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the respondent police did not serve any R.C.S. notice to the petitioner.

4.The petitioner is given liberty to file protest petition before the concerned Judicial Magistrate within a period of one

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month from the date of receipt of copy of this order. On such petition, the concerned Judicial Magistrate is directed to consider the same in accordance with law and to pass suitable orders within a period of one month therefrom.

5. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
