3.Recording the aforesaid submissions, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.

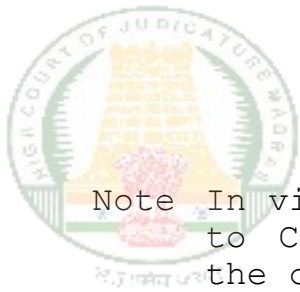
