ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.K.R.SHIVASHANKARI, Advocate for the petitioner, the court made the following order:-



The matter has been listed today under the caption 'for clarification'.

2.The present petition has been filed to condone the delay of 203 days in filing the above appeal and this Court by order dated 08.02.2021, has condoned the delay on payment of cost of Rs.1,500/- to the Legal Services Committee within two weeks.

3.Today, the learned counsel for the petitioner would state that instead of paying the cost of Rs.1,500/- to the Legal Services Committee, inadvertently, she has paid Rs.1,000/- and therefore, the cost memo was returned for insufficient payment of cost. She would further state now the balance cost amount of Rs.500/- has been paid and the cost memo has been again filed into the Registry along with the receipt for Rs.500/-. Thus, she would pray to number the appeal.

4.In view of the above submission, the delayed payment of cost is accepted and Registry is directed to number the appeal, if the papers are otherwise in order and list the same for admission.
