Arulmigu Sri Muppidthiamman Procession Car Festival for the Arulmigu Sri Muppidthiamman Temple Situated at Sengottai Taluk, Vadakarai, Tenkasi District on the basis of the Petitioner's representation dated 04.02.2021.

ORDER

But, the petitioner was not given permission for Karagaattam and Sendamelam. Hence, the petitioner prays this Court that permission to be granted for Karagaattam and Sendamelam.

4. On the side of the respondents, it is stated that the respondents are ready to consider the grievance of the petitioner, if he files a fresh representation.



5. Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation before the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tenkasi and on such representation, the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tenkasi, is directed to consider and pass orders on the representation of the petitioner on the same day, in accordance with law.

6. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
