ORDER

The petitioner is the first accused in Crime No.262 of 2010 of Karambakudi Police Station, Karambakudi, Pudukkottai District and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 341 and 323 of IPC r/w Sections 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 1989.

2.The present petition filed by the petitioner is to direct the Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989), Pudukkottai, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.R.Srinivasan, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4.The prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the



petitioner and consider the bail application, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioner should appear before the Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989), Pudukkottai, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor and by complying Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
