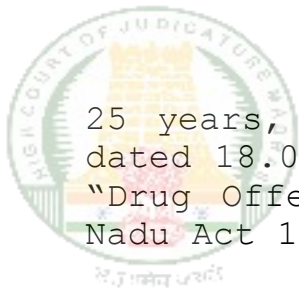

25 years, challenging the detention order in P.D.No.1 of 2021, dated 18.01.2021, passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Drug Offender" as contemplated under Section 2(e) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Standing counsel appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.1027, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIV) Department, dated 27.02.2020, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.
