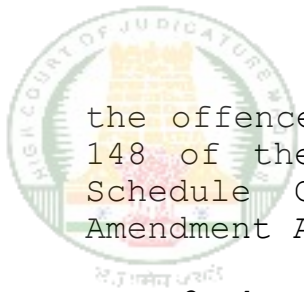

**ORDER**

The petitioners are the accused 3,4,5,8 and 9 in Crime No.259 of 2012 of Parthibanoor Police Station, Ramanathapuram District and

the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 3(1)(x) of the Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.

2.The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge (PCR Act Cases), Ramanathapuram, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.R.Erottuchamy, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The respondents 3 to 6 are the victim.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application on the same day of surrender, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Ramanathapuram, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
