3.Recording the said submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

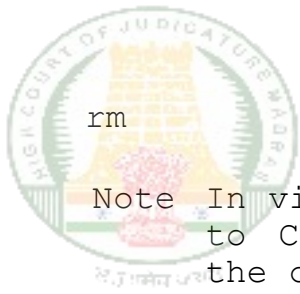
