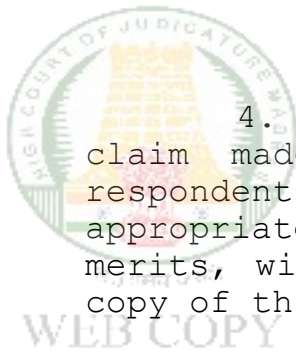

3.Mr.S.Sundarapandian, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is the Secretary of Student Union Wing of AIADMK Party, Puliyarai, Tenkasi District and that they intend to conduct Kabadi Tournament on 20.02.2021 and 21.02.2021 at Puliyarai Village. His further contention is that he has submitted a representation dated 13.02.2021 to the second respondent seeking permission to conduct the said Tournament and till date, no action has been taken by the respondents.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, this Court directs the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law based on findings and on merits, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order/uploading of the order.

5. With the above observation, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
