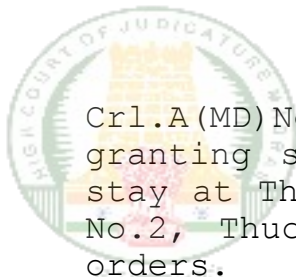
**Prayer in CRL A(MD) No.265 of 2020.:**

To call for the records and set aside the order of conviction and sentence passed in SC No.105 of 2012 dated 27.02.2020 on the file of the Principal Sessions Judge, Sivagangai District at Sivagangai and allow this appeal and Acquit the appellants/ Accused from the charges levelled against them.

**Order :** This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.T.KUMAR, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.R.ANANDHARAJ, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent, the Court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed seeking relaxation of the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P(MD)No.6218 of 2020 in

Cr1.A(MD)No.265 of 2020, dated 11.12.2020. This Court while granting suspension of sentence to the petitioner directed him to stay at Thuckalay and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Thuckalay at 10.30 a.m., on all working days until further orders.

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2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would state that the petitioner has been complying with the said condition from 31.12.2020. He is an agriculturists and he is the sole bread winner of his family consisting 3 minor children and aged parents, so, he is not able to stay at Thuckalay to comply the condition.

3. Heard the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

4. In the light of the above statement of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the condition imposed on the petitioner in Cr1.M.P(MD)No.6218 of 2020, dated 11.12.2020 is modified directing the petitioner to appear before the committal court once in a week I.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

5. Accordingly, this petition is ordered.
