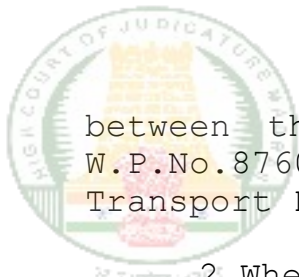
Prayer in WP(MD). 21617/ 2017 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records pursuant to the impugned order passed by the 3rd Respondent in his Letter No.4260/Nir.9/Tha.A.Po.Ka/Thili/2006 dated 18.07.2017 and the consequential impugned order passed by the 1st Respondent in Letter No.12497/EPa.1/2013-12, dated 20.07.2017, quash the same as illegal and consequently directing the Respondents to sanction pension to the petitioner w.e.f 17.04.1982 as per G.O.Ms.No.42 Transport Department, dated 27.05.2005 and to pay all arrears with interest.
