5.In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, it is made clear that now the presence of the petitioner is not necessary to the respondent police either for interrogation or for enquiry.

6.Recording the said submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this criminal original petition is closed.
