This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.311 of 2020 in Crl.A.(MD)No.31 of 2020, dated 21.02.2020.

2.On the side of the petitioner, it is stated that the petitioner is complying with the condition from 27.02.2020 till

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21.03.2020 and after, the lock down is released from 01.09.2020 till today and prayed the condition to be relaxed.

3. On the side of the prosecution, it is fairly admitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition as above stated.

4. In view of the above submissions, this petition is allowed and the condition already imposed on the petitioner is relaxed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the concerned Court as and when required for interrogation.

5. Post the main appeal on 22.03.2021.
