Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited relief sought for in this writ petition, there shall be a direction to the respondent to consider the appeal filed by the petitioner on 05.09.2015 after affording an opportunity to the petitioner and the above said Pethanan and shall pass final orders, strictly in accordance with law within a period of eight (08) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



4. The petitioner is directed to make a fresh representation to the respondent, along with a copy of this order. The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
