Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Declaration, declaring the action of the respondents in taking written undertaking dated 08.02.2013 from the petitioner to give up his statutory right under Section 47 (1) of Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 and the order of discharge passed by the

4.Recording the submission of the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents, this Contempt Petition is closed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition, if the order of this Court is not complied with.

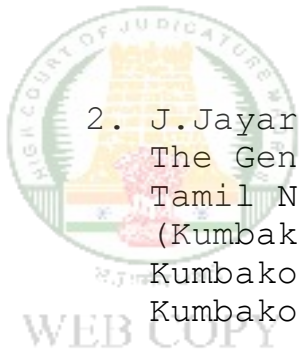
