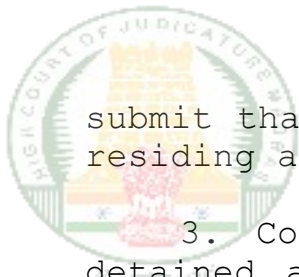

Alleging that the petitioner's husband by name Venkatesh @ Viji, aged about 36 years, is found missing from 09.11.2020, the petitioner has given a complaint before the respondents police. But, so far no action has been taken by the respondents police to secure the detenu. Hence, the present Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the respondent police has produced the detenu and on enquiry, he would



submit that due to a matrimonial dispute, he left the house and residing at Sivagangai and he is a mason.

3. Considering the above facts, the detenu is not illegal detained as alleged by the petitioner. Hence, the Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.
