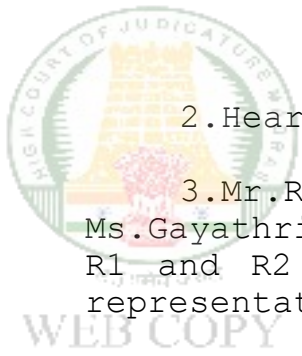

This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 539 days in preferring the Criminal Revision Case against the dismissal order, dated 25.06.2018 made in R.C.S.No.23 of 2018 on the file of the learned Additional District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate,

4.Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition and in the interest of justice, this petition is allowed on payment of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) to the Chief Justice Relief Fund (payable in Accounts Section of the High Court Registry), on or before 29.07.2021, failing which this petition shall stand dismissed automatically without further reference to this Court.
