PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.8 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 341, 323, 324 and 506(i) of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prevention of Women Harassment Act, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the de-facto complainant, the petitioner said to have attacked the de-facto complainant with iron rod and also caused injuries. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the injured was treated as outpatient.

5.It is seen that the de-facto complainant is the wife of the petitioner, there was some quarrel between the parties, the



petitioner attacked the de-facto complainant with iron rod and the injured was treated as outpatient. In this regard, the de-facto complainant lodged a present complaint in Crime No.8 of 2021 before the respondent police and after the case was came to be registered under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C.

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6.Taking note of the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

7.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Tenkasi, Tenkasi District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a)the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
