ORDER

The petitioners are the accused Nos.1 and 6 to 8 in Crime No.196 of 2021 of Valangaiman Police Station, Madurai and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 448, 324 and 506(ii) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 (1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 2015.

2. The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned I Additional District Judge (PCR Act Cases), Thanjavur, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to also consider the bail applications on the same day.

accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant. The respondents 4 to 8 are the victim.

4. Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to consider the bail application on the same day of surrender, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1) The petitioners should appear before the learned I Additional District Judge(PCR Act Cases), Thanjavur, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.

2) On such surrender, the concerned I Additional District Judge, may consider the bail applications filed by the petitioners on merits, on the same day of their surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
