2. Leave is granted. This criminal original petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

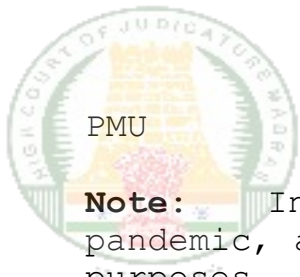
