PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime no. 412 of 2020 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A3, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 323, 353 and 379 of IPC and Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No.412 of 2020 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and others were said to have illegally transported river sand by using lorry. Hence, the present complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the occurrence said to have taken place on 12.11.2020 and for the past three months the respondent police is
