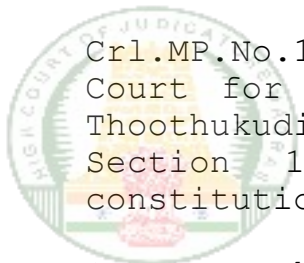
Prayer in Crl.M.P No 1946 of 2022 :-

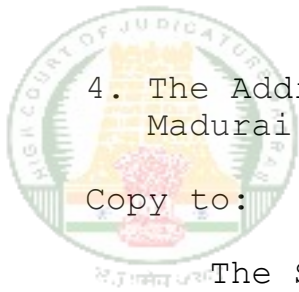
