the Respondent Police

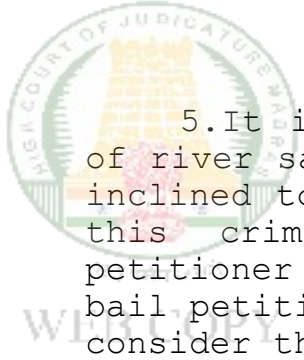
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections
379 IPC and Section 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development &
Regulation) Act 1957 in Crime No.42 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner illegally
transported 1/4 unit of river sand. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner are innocent person and he did not commit any offence as
alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the
respondent police submitted that there is no previous case pending
against the petitioner.



5. It is seen that the petitioner illegally transported ¼ unit of river sand. Considering the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Court and file a bail petition. On such filing of the petition, the Court below shall consider the same and pass orders on the same day, on its own merits and in accordance with law.
