2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that a batch of writ petition was allowed along with the writ petition in W.P(MD).No.17049 of 2012. Subsequently, he came to know that the order passed in the batch of writ petitions was set aside, at the instance of the review application filed by the State in Review application Nos.70 to 79 of 2015 etc batch. As against the said order, the aggrieved persons have filed S.L.P before the Hon'ble Apex Court in S.L.P.Nos.24326-24335 of 2018.

3.In view of the above, this Court granted liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law, after the disposal of the S.L.P filed by the similarly placed persons. Hence, this Contempt Petition is closed with the aforesaid liberty.
