ORDER

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking for a direction to the second respondent to provide police protection to him.

2.Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side), who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2, on instructions, would submit that the representation submitted by the petitioner was registered in CSR.No.46 of 2021 and posted for enquiry. He further submit that the petitioner's property has been surveyed and boundaries are also fixed as requested by the petitioner and that now the petitioner wants to fence his property, for which, he seeks police protection.

3.In the circumstances, the second respondent is directed to dispose of the representation submitted by the petitioner based on findings and on merits within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order/uploading of the order, after giving sufficient opportunity to the third respondent.



4. With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
