4.With the above observation, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.

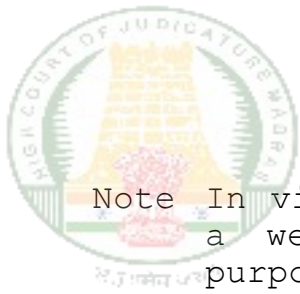
