Prayer : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to direct the I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of cases under Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Thanjavur, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender in Crime No.196 of 2021 on the file of the second respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioners are the accused 2, 3 and 5 in Crime No.196 of 2021 of Valangaiman Police Station, Thiruvarur District, and the offences alleged against the accused are under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 448, 324 and 506 (ii) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015.

2.The present petition filed by the petitioners is to direct the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special

Court for Exclusive Trial of cases under Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Thanjavur, to accept the surrender of the petitioners and also to consider the bail application on the same day.

3.Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. The third respondent is the de-facto complainant.

4.Since the prayer itself is to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail application on the same day, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

- 1) The petitioners should appear before the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of cases under Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act Cases, Thanjavur, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order / uploading of the order.
- 2) On such surrender, concerned Sessions Judge, may consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on merits on the same day of surrender, after giving notice to the concerned Public Prosecutor.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
